

**K** NOW all Men by these Presents, That we  
*Mary Jameson Widow & Samuel Jameson Yeoman John*  
*Patten Gent & John Fullon, Yeoman. & all of Topham in*  
*said County of Lincoln*

are holden and stand firmly bound and obliged unto *Jonathan*  
*Bowman Esq.* his Successors or Assigns, in the full Sum of  
*One thousand Pounds*  
*Jonathan Bowman Esq.* to be paid unto the said  
his Successors or Assigns,  
in the Office of Judge of Probate of Wills, and for granting Letters of  
Administration on the Estates of Persons deceased, in the said County of  
*Lincoln* To the true Payment whereof, we jointly and severally  
bind ourselves, and our several and respective Heirs, Executors, and  
Administrators, firmly by these Presents. Sealed with our Seals. Dated  
the *27<sup>th</sup>* Day of *May* in the Year of our LORD, 1791.

**T**HE Condition of this Obligation is such,  
That whereas the above-bounden *Mary Jameson & Samuel*  
*Jameson* have this Day taken upon  
*them* the Trust of Executors to the last Will and Testament of  
*Samuel Jameson* late of  
*Topham* in the County of *Lincoln* deceased;  
and by a Law of this Commonwealth, made and passed in the Year  
of our LORD, one Thousand seven Hundred and Eighty-four, entitled  
“An Act prescribing the Manner of devising Lands, Tenements and  
Hereditaments,” it is enacted, “That every Executor named in a Will  
hereafter to be proved, and taking upon him that Trust by proving  
the same, shall give Bond to the Judge of Probate, with sufficient  
Surety or Sureties, to return, upon Oath, a true and perfect Inventory  
of the Testator’s Estate, into the Probate-Office, within three Months,  
and to render an Account of his Proceedings thereon, in the same  
Manner Administrators are by Law obliged to be bound.”

NOW THEREFORE, if the above-bounden *Mary Jameson*  
*and Samuel Jameson* shall well and truly  
observe and perform the Conditions aforesaid in said Act mentioned,  
according to the true Intent and Meaning thereof, then this Obligation  
to be void and of no effect; otherwise to remain in full Force and Virtue.
